# EXPIRY OF FLEET MANAGEMENT CONTRACT

## PUBLIC NOTICE

The municipality entered into a vehicle lease contract with a fleet management company in 2017.

This was a three-year contract, which included the leasing of a variety of vehicles for service delivery purposes.

The term of the contract has expired, and the company is expected to withdraw its vehicles.

In preparation for a smooth transition of the service (fleet), the municipality previously looked at various options with a view of ensuring that there would be no interruption of vehicle-reliant service delivery.

However, none of the options was favourable to the municipality at the time.

The municipality is currently working on an urgent and interim plan to avail necessary vehicles for critical services that include waste management, water and sanitation, electricity and cemeteries, thus avoiding interruption of services.

The process of the municipality purchasing its own fleet has also commenced. Interaction with relevant stakeholders, which include National Treasury, on the matter of purchasing vehicles is underway.
