

OPENING OF LICENSING CENTRES (BRITS & HARTBEESPOORT)

PUBLIC NOTICE

- 1. The Brits and Hartbeespoort Licensing Centres will be opened to members of the public on Tuesday, 02 June 2020.
- 2. For safety of staff and members of the public the Brits Licensing Centre will only allow 150 people access to the facility on a daily basis.
- 3. For the same reason Hartbeespoort Registration Authority will only allow 50 people a day at the centre.
- 4. Members of the public must take note of the principle:

"No face mask, No entry"

- 5. Furthermore, members of the public must subject themselves to social distancing, hands sanitization, screening process and complete the register for tracking purposes.
- 6. The Driving License Testing Centre (DLTC) will only assist with the following transactions for the 1st and 2nd week of June 2020 (02 to 12 June 2020)
 - · Collection of license cards people that completed their transactions before the lockdown
 - Issuing of Driver's License to applicants that passed their tests in March 2020
 - Issuing of Learner Licenses to applicants that passed their test during March 2020
 - Renewal of expired driver and PrDP licenses
 - From the 15th June 2020 the DLTC will open for applicants to make bookings for learner and drivers licenses
- 7. The Registration Authority (RA), both Brits and Hartbeespoort will during the first week, 02-05 June 2020, only assist with the renewal of expired vehicle licenses. The two centres will from the second week, 08 June 2020 onwards, assist with all transactions.
- 8. Members of the public are advised that where it's financially possible, they should consider conducting their eye tests with any registered optometrist (this will assist in further enhancing health and safety measures)
- 9. No vehicle will be allowed to park in the Licensing yard and drivers are strictly requested to park their vehicles off the roadway of Kaptein Barnard street
- 10. No 'Runners' will be allowed to conduct their business on the municipal premises.
- 11. Members of the public are warned not to give their money and or documents to any person claiming to conduct legal business with the Licensing centre and will thus assist them with obtaining their vehicle and or driver's license.
- 12. On Friday, 05 June 2020, the Brits DLTC will be reserved for assistance of pensioners and essential services workers (Emergency Medical Services, SAPS, Traffic, Health, Social Development, SASSA, Fire and Disaster)
- 13. The municipality appreciates the co-operation from the members of the public
